CRIER.

1870, c. 180 repeals and re-enacts section 89 as follows:

1870, c. 180.
Pay of crier.

89. The crier of the circuit court for said county shall be entitled to two dollars and fifty cents per day for each day he may be employed as such.

FISH.

1870, c. 75 enacts as follows:

1870, c. 75, s. 1.
Fishing in
Israel's creek
prohibited

102. Sub-Sec. 1. No person or persons shall in any manner or way, except by hook and line, fish in the waters of Israel's creek, in Washington county, from the date of the passage of this act until the first day of April, A. D., 1872.

Penalty.

Sub-Sec. 2. Any person or persons violating the preceding section shall pay a fine of five dollars for each and every offence, to be recovered before a justice of the peace of said county, one-half of which fine shall be paid to the county commissioners for the use of the public schools of said county, and the other half to the informer.

JERUSALEM.

1870, c. 452 enacts as follows:

Incorporated.

183. The citizens of the town of Jerusalem, in Washington county, are a body corporate, by the name of the burgess and commissioners of Jerusalem, and by that
