

JUSTICES OF THE PEACE AND CONSTABLES.

1870, c. 11 repeals section 204 and re-enacts the same as follows.

1870, c. 11.
Number of, in
each district.

204. There shall be the following number of justices of the peace and constables for Washington county, to wit: For election district number one, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number two, three justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number three, three justices of the peace and four constables; for election district number four, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number five, three justices of the peace and two constables, one of which justices shall always be taken from the town of Hancock; for election district number six, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number seven, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number eight, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number nine, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number ten, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election [district] number eleven, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number twelve, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number thirteen, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number fourteen, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number fifteen, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number sixteen, two justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number seventeen, two justices of the peace and two constables.

Approved and in force February 19, 1870.
