

the time of said repeal, under said article, or any section thereof; nor shall it impair, discharge or release any contract, obligation, duty, liability or penalty whatsoever now existing; but that all suits and actions pending, and all prosecutions for penalties, crimes or misdemeanors under said article, including all civil and criminal proceedings whatsoever, shall be prosecuted and proceeded with to final determination, and judgment entered therein as if said article had not been repealed; and all acts or parts of acts heretofore passed, inconsistent with the provisions of this article as re-enacted; and re-enacts said article 81, with amendments.

1874, c. 514, entitled an act to provide for the general valuation and assessment of property in this state, enacts ss. numbered 1 to 36.

1874, c. 408, repeals 1872, c. 234, and re-enacts the same with amendments, as ss. 150 to 158, inclusive, and adds the same to this article.
