ARTICLE XXX.

Crimes and Punishments.

1867, c. 64, repeals sects. 69, 70, 71 and 72, relating to importing convicts or slaves; sects. 75 and 77, relating to incendiary publications; sects. 94, 95, 96 and 97, relating to sale of slaves; sec. 128, relating to marriage of negroes and whites; sec. 141, relating to murder; sects. 146, 147, 148, 149 and 150, relating to negroes; sects. 153 and 154, relating to passes to negroes; sec. 168, relating to negroes near camp meetings; and sects. 174, 175, 176 and 177, relating to runaway slaves.
