1872, c. 313, an act to protect the owners of land on the waters of Queen Anne's and Kent counties.

1872, c. 320, an act for the protection of black bass and all other fish in the Monocacy river and its tributaries, within the limits of Frederick county; and see 1874, c. 173, repealing and re-enacting s. 1, of 1872, c. 320.

1874, c. 79, an act for the protection of black bass and other fish in the Patapsco river above tide-water.

1874, c. 129, an act for the protection of fish, &c., in the creeks of Montgomery county.

1874, c. 139, an act to prevent the hunting, catching, &c., of terrapins, &c., in Somerset county.

1874, c. 348, an act to protect fish in the Great Gunpowder river, &c., in Baltimore county.

1874, c. 383, an act to prevent non-residents from catching or taking fish in Monie bay, &c., in Somerset county.

1874, c. 388, an act for the protection of young fish in Elk river and North East river, in Cecil county.

1874, c. 400, repealing certain sects. of the pub. local laws, and enacting in lieu of the sects. so repealed, relating to the counties of Dorchester, Talbot and Caroline.

1874, c. 492, an act to prevent the catching, &c., of fish in Pocomoke river and sound, in Somerset county.
