ARTICLE ———.

Registration.

1865, c. 159, enacts that there shall be added to the public general laws a new article, bearing the title "Registration," under which shall be arranged by titles and sections, as in other articles of the code, the laws to be made by the General Assembly on the subject of the registry of births, marriages, deaths and voters, as required by article III. of the constitution of 1864, sects. 41 and 49; and such other subjects of registration as the legislature may enact and direct.
