- 37. It shall not be lawful for any person or persons whatsoever 1878, c 363, subto haul in the waters of the Patuxent river, between Sheriden's Prohibitions. Point and Point Patience, any seine of greater length than sixty fathoms, at any time between the first day of June and the first day of October following
- 38. Any person violating the provisions of this last-mentioned Id sub-sec 4. section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before a justice of the peace for Calvert county, or before the Circuit Court of Calvert county, shall be fined a sum not less than twenty dollars nor more than fifty dollars, one half thereof to be paid to the informer and the other half thereof to the county commissioners of said county.

39. No person shall stake down any seine or net across the 1874, c 313 Patuxent river for the purpose of taking shad or herring; nor Stake nets and beating waters shall any person whip, thrash, or beat the waters of the Patuxent prohibited river with poles or any other instruments for the purpose of driving fish into any seine or net; nor shall any person in fishing in the said river, between the fifth day of March and the fifteenth day of May, Regulations in use any seine or net with meshes of less size than one and three-regard to seines eighths of an inch square, or during the rest of the year with any seine or net with meshes of a less size than two inches square, and no person shall empty any seine except in water twelve inches deep; and any person violating this section shall be subject to the fine and forfeitures provided in the twenty-second section of this article.

40. No vessel, float, raft, or boat of any description, unless com- 1874, c so A. pelled to do so by stress of weather or other unavoidable accident, Vessels, floats, etc, not to be shall be anchored or stayed in the berth or haul of any regularly anchored in haul of fishing hauled fishing shore in the Patuxent river, and remain thus an-shore. chored for the space of half an hour, when the weather will permit the departure of such vessel, raft, float, or boat, after being warned to depart therefrom by the owner or occupant of said fishery.

41. Any person violating the preceding section shall pay to the Id B owner of said fishery, a fine of twenty dollars for each offence, and Penalty every hour the vessel, float, or boat continues after the half hour mentioned in the preceding section, shall be considered a new and separate offence.

42. The captain or owner of the vessel, float, or boat referred to Id C in the preceding two sections, shall be liable to pay said fine, and Captain and vessel hable, the vessel, float, or boat so anchored and stayed as above mentioned, shall also be liable to be seized and sold to pay any fines imposed under the preceding sections.

43. If any such vessel, float, or boat shall be willingly, wantonly Id D and maliciously or from gross negligence sailed through any seine Fine for wanextended in any of said fisheries, the skipper, captain, or other per- through series son commanding such vessel, float, or boat, shall pay to the owner or holder of such seine not less than twenty, nor more than one hundred dollars, at the discretion of the justice of the peace trying the case.
