receiving a majority of votes cast at such meeting shall be declared duly elected to serve until the annual election.

127. Any person taxed for any ditch which does not pass through Id & 88 1858, c 271, s 11. or upon his land, may open a ditch or ditches through the interven-Cross ditches ing lands into such main ditch or ditches, and keep the same open at his own cost and charge; provided, that no such cross ditch shall be cut through the land of any other person without the consent of the owner of such land, unless the same be laid out and approved, and the damages thereon accruing to the owner of the land assessed Damages by the commissioners appointed to lay out the main ditch, or by three freeholders appointed by the county commissioners for said county, for the purpose of assessing such damages

128. The person applying for such cross ditch, shall pay all the Id # 89 costs of laying out and opening the same; and shall also, before Persons applymaking such ditch, tender or pay all damages awarded to such per- ages and costs sons as may be injured thereby.

129. Whenever, in the opinion of the commissioners, the owner 10 s 90 of the intervening land, or any other person whose lands are situated Continuous, at the head or above such cross ditch, will derive any benefit from when to be made. cutting the same, then the said owner of the intervening land, or other person benefited, shall contribute and pay such sum or sums How levied respectively as the commissioners shall determine to be his or their proportionable part of the damage, costs, and expenses for laying out and making such cross ditch or ditches.

130. Every ditch so made shall always remain open for the Id s 91 benefit of such persons, their heirs and assigns, as the commissioners, Ditches to rein their report, shall return as being benefited thereby, and chargea-benefit of taxble with the expense of making the same; but if any ditch laid out payers as aforesaid shall not be begun within two years from the confirma- when order tion of the return, or being begun, shall not be completed within void seven years thereafter, the said order and return shall become void and be of no effect, and the power and authority under it shall cease.

131. If any person shall stop up any ditch made in pursuance Id s 92 hereof, except by such fixtures under fences as may be necessary to Penalty for prevent stock from trespassing through said ditch, and shall be law-ditches fully convicted thereof before a justice of the peace of the county, he shall forfeit and pay for every such offence a sum not less than two nor more than twenty dollars, to be recovered by the managers for the time being, and applied to the use of said ditch.

132. The commissioners appointed as hereinbefore directed, Id 8 93 shall each receive for every day's attendance in the discharge of 1858, c 271, s 14 their duties, the sum of one dollar.

133. The managers appointed as aforesaid, shall each receive Id s 94 one dollar and fifty cents for every day they shall be engaged in the Pay of discharge of their duty; the surveyor, such reasonable compensa- managers. tion as shall be agreed upon between the parties; and the clerk of the county commissioners, who is hereby required to keep a record
