PROVING DEBTS AGAINST ESTATE.

- 149 Administrator not to pay claims unless proven or passed
- 150 Judgments or decrees, how proven
- 151 Special bail discharging judgment, substituted for judgment creditor
- 152 If more than one creditor, what sufficient
- 153 Proofs of specialty, bond, note, or protested bill of exchange
- 154 When assigned
- 155 In case of bill of exchange protest required
- 156 Claim for rent, how proven

PAYMENT OF DEBTS

- 170 When administrator to make distribution of money in hand
- 171 Administrator may give notice of dividend, creditor failing to attend, interest shall cease, proviso
- 172 When administrator to retain for claims, when for claims out of State, interest
- to cease from date of dividend, proceedings, if creditor claims more than dividend
- 173 Order of payment of debts
- 174 Administrator not bound to notice claim unless proven or passed, etc
- 175 May appoint meeting of creditors

SUITS AGAINST ADMINISTRATORS, ETC.

- 176 When administration bond may be sued by creditor
- 177. Administrator to retain to meet suits
- 178. Creditor to bring suit within nine months after rejection of claim
 - When administrator answerable on claim after notice

PAYMENT OF LEGACIES.
