or neglect of an executor or person entitled to administration to qualify, or from any other cause; and such letters may be granted to one or more persons in the discretion of the court in case the personal estate of the deceased shall be supposed to be in different counties.

Witness ----, chief justice of the Orphans' Court of ---- county. Test: C. D., register of wills for ----- county."

99. Every collector, before such letters shall be granted to him, Id 8 62 shall execute a bond to the State in a penalty, and with security 1798, c 101, sub-c 3, s 16 approved by the said court, to be filed, recorded, and sued as an Bond administration bond with the following condition: "The condition Condition of of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden shall well and honestly discharge the office of collector of the goods, chattels, and personal estate and debts of -----, deceased, in the State of Maryland (or ---- county); and shall make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect inventory or inventories of such said goods, chattels, personal estate, and debts, as shall come to his possession or knowledge, and the same shall in due time return to the register of wills of ---- county, and shall also deliver to the person or persons who shall be authorized by the Orphans' Court of said county to receive them, such of the said goods, chattels, personal estate, and debts, as shall come to his possession (except such as shall be allowed for by the said court), then the above obligation is to be void, or it is otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in law."
