- July, and October in each year, pay to the treasurer of the State the one-half of all fees received by him for protests, and on failure to comply with the requirements of this section, he shall forfeit, in each case, the sum of fifty dollars, to be collected and paid for the use of the State.
- 34. Every notary public, before he shall be commissioned or authorized to discharge the duties of his office, shall give bond to the State of Maryland, with security to be approved by the governor, in the penalty of six thousand dollars, if appointed for the city of Baltimore, and in the penalty of two thousand dollars, if appointed for any county, conditioned for the payment into the treasury of that portion of the notarial fees received by him, for the use of the State; and if any person appointed a notary public shall neglect or refuse to give such bond within thirty days from the date of his appointment, the governor shall appoint some other person in his place.
