What lien claim shall set forth	63	19	984
Where claim is filed, by contractor, persons to whom he is indebted for work done or materials furnished in or for the building to have benefit of such lien	63	20	984
When filed against two or more buildings, claim shall designate amount due by each building	63	21	984
Machine, bridges and wharves to be subject in like manner to lien	63	22	985
Lien to be good for six months after work done or materials furnished	63	23	985
But no longer, unless lien claim be filed at or before expiration of such six months	63	23	985
Remedy to be by bill in equity or by <i>scire facias</i>	63	24	985
