7. One member of said board may grant any certificate provided for in this article to any applicant, upon presentation by such applicant of the evidence requisite for the obtaining said certificate; which certificate shall remain in force until the next regular meeting of the said board after the granting of said certificate, and no longer; but no such certificate shall be issued by such member after such applicant has been rejected by said board.
