the State, any goods, wares or merchandise, until he shall have first taken out a license for that purpose; but nothing in this section shall apply to hawkers and pedlars of oysters and fish in their unpreserved and natural condition, or of fruits and vegetables perishable in their nature, that are sold in their natural condition in this State.

Any hawker or pedlar who may be found trading, bartering or selling, or offering to trade, barter or sell, any goods, wares or merchandise, without a license, may be apprehended by any sheriff or constable within their respective bailiwicks; and it shall be the duty of said sheriff and constable to apprehend him and carry him before a justice of the peace of the county.

If it shall appear to said justice that said hawker or pedlar has bought, traded, bartered or sold, or offered to buy, trade, barter or sell, any goods, wares or merchandise, without license, he shall impose a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars, nor less than twenty-five dollars, to be recovered as other fines are recoverable, and to be paid to the clerk of the circuit court or court of common pleas of Baltimore city.
