107. There shall be two regular common-law terms of the circuit court for Anne Arundel county at the city of Annapolis, commencing respectively on the third Monday in April and fourth Monday in October in each year.

108. The judges of the circuit court for Anne Arundel county, in their discretion, may appoint intermediate terms between the common-law terms, for the transaction of equity business, and any other business not requiring a jury, to which process shall be returnable.

109. Whenever a judgment, or decree, or decretal order is rendered or passed in said court, it shall be the duty of the clerk to enter upon an index to be kept for that purpose, the names of all defendants against whom the same shall have been rendered or passed.
