said bond shall make affidavit before said clerk, or before a justice of the peace of said county, that said surety is the owner in fee simple of real estate in Harford county of the assessed value, over and above all incumbrances, of at least one thousand dollars, and that said surety has not within the current year executed a bond for any other applicant to sell spirituous or fermented liquors in said city.

190. The clerk of the circuit court may in his discretion require such further and other proof, by the written affidavit of other parties, to be filed in his office, as to the sufficiency of said bond, as he may deem proper; and if said clerk shall wilfully or negligently grant a license to any person who shall not have complied with the provisions of said sections of this sub-title of this article, said clerk shall, upon indictment and conviction thereof, be fined not less than fifty dollars nor more than three hundred dollars for each offence.

191. No license to sell spirituous or fermented liquors in said city shall be granted to any applicant therefor, until such person shall file a written affidavit, sworn to before said clerk, that said applicant has bona fide, and without intending to evade the spirit and meaning of said sections of this sub-title of this article, duly provided, and will at all times during the continuance of said license, maintain and keep for use at least three chambers more than are needed for such person's own private or family purposes, for the reception of guests or permanent or transient boarders, and at least four beds, with sufficient covering therefor, and stabling for at least six horses, and that said chambers and bedsare and shall remain upon the said premises; and in which shall be stated the name and residence of the applicant, and the location of the premises on which the business is to be conducted, with name of the owner thereof, and that said applicant has not been convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of sections 188-214.

192. No license to sell spirituous or fermented liquors in said city shall be granted to any applicant who has complied with the
