

State's attorney for said county shall, before the trial of such alleged offence, pray a jury trial on the part of the State, it shall be the duty of any justice to commit such alleged offender for trial, or to hold the said offender to bail to appear for trial in the circuit court for the said county at its then session, if it be then in session, or at its next session, if it be not then in session, and to return said commitment or recognizance, with the name and residence of the witnesses for the prosecution endorsed thereon, forthwith to the clerk of said court; and the justice before whom the case is tried shall inform the person charged of his right to a jury trial.

236. In any indictment under this sub-title of this article for violations of the provisions of the preceding sections thereof, it shall not be necessary to specify the particular kind of liquor which any person, house, company, association or body corporate, bartered, sold or gave away, or solicited or received orders for the purchase of, or kept deposited or had, with intent to barter, sell or give away, or that the same be bartered, sold or given away in violation of said provisions; but it shall be sufficient if the indictment sets forth that the traverser bartered, sold or gave away, or solicited or received orders for the purchase of, or kept deposited or had, with intent to barter, sell or give away spirituous or fermented liquors or intoxicating drinks, or with intent that the same be bartered, sold or given away in violation of said provisions.
