121. Every dog in Prince George's county, except one dog to each and every family, and dogs under the age of six months, and such as are taxed by the incorporated towns within the limits of the county, shall be liable to an annual tax of one dollar for each and every male, and one dollar and a half for each and every female; and every owner of such animal or animals,
