BALTIMORE COUNTY.

Birds and Game.

1. What birds unlawful to kill.
 2. Unlawful to disturb eggs of such.
 3. Penalty for violation of sections 1 and 2, prosecution to be before justice of the peace.
 4. Possession of such birds *prima facie* evidence of guilt.
 5. Rabbits and woodcocks, when lawful to kill
 6. Violation of section 5, penalty.
 - 7 Non-residents must procure license to kill such, penalty
 8. Possession of game mentioned in sections 5, 6, 7, *prima facie* evidence of guilt
 9. To whom fines are to be paid.
 10. Duty of constables and police.
 11. Bounty paid for destruction of hawks.
 12. Party applying for bounty to produce heads of, before justice, certificate and duty of justice.
 13. Justice not entitled to a fee for certificate
 14. County commissioners to have discretionary power as to the payment of such bounty.
