SOMERSET COUNTY.

Almshouse.

1. Trustees of the poor.
2. Trustees of poor, certificate of appointment.
3. Trustees of poor; acceptance compulsory, to qualify, when and how.
4. Trustees of poor; who not compelled to serve; who ineligible.
5. Trustees of poor, vacancies, how filled.
6. Trustees of poor; a body corporate; corporate name, may hold devises and gifts, lands.
7. Trustees of poor; seal.
8. Trustees of poor; meetings; rules and by-laws.
9. Overseer, physician; other agents and laborers
10. Overseer, bond.
11. Overseer; pay.
12. Overseer; removable.
13. Overseer; required to keep list of persons committed to.
14. Overseer; accounts.
15. Inmates may be compelled to work; product of their labor.
16. Clerk to trustees of the poor.
17. Products of farm, if more than sufficient for needs of institution; if insufficient.

20. Trustee of poor not to furnish supplies to, in his own right; penalty.

21. Disorderly persons; commitment to, security for good behavior.

25. Inmates, selling to, or buying from; penalty.
26. Sheriffs, constables and all other officers to aid trustees and their employees.
27. Suits on account of acts done in accordance with provisions of this sub-title, pleading; costs, by whom paid.
28. Pay of trustees of poor.

Apprentices.

29. Justices of the peace may bind out, manner and restrictions.
30. Hiring apprentice to trade other than that to which he was first bound.
31. Orphans' court may order return to master of apprentice hired out.
