P. L. L., (1860,) art. 19, sec. 1.

1. The county commissioners of Somerset county, on the first Tuesday of April in each year, or at their first meeting thereafter, shall appoint three persons, to be styled "Trustees of the poor for Somerset county," one of whom shall be a resident of the old upper district, one of the old middle district, and one of the old lower district of said county, and any two of whom shall be a quorum to transact business, and they shall continue in office until their successors shall be appointed and shall have qualified.
