121. Exempt from sections 157-162, of article 81 of public general laws relating to tax upon.

Election Districts.

122. Twenty-three; elections to be held at places already established.
123. County commissioners may create new.
124. Compensation of judges and clerks.

Fences.

125. Height of worm, brush, stone and other.
126. Section 125 to refer only to outside
