156. It shall not be lawful for the clerk of the circuit court to issue license to any person to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer at Messrs. Brigham, Hopkins and Company's hat factory, situated in Saint Denis, Baltimore county, or at any place within one mile thereof.
