The county commissioners, at their first meeting in January in every second year, accounting from the year eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, shall appoint for each election district of said county, three persons, discreet and trustworthy taxpayers, residents of such districts, to act as road commissioners of that district for the term of two years, computing from the first day of January, or until their successors are appointed; the commissioners thus appointed in each district shall constitute a board of road commissioners for that district, one of whom shall be elected by said board to act as chairman; they shall each give bond to the county commissioners, properly conditioned for the faithful performance of their duties, in the penal sum of one thousand dollars.
