

80. Purchaser of real estate bound to pay duty; entitled to credit therefor.
81. All goods to be knocked down to highest bidder; owner or auctioneer buying to pay duty; this section not to legalize sales otherwise fraudulent.
82. Auctioneers, appointment, number of.
83. Bond when sales, exclusive of real estate sales, do not exceed \$150,000; license.
84. Privileges of auctioneer paying license and giving bond, returns of sales to be made quarterly; selling under special license.
85. Bond when sales exceed \$150,000, license.
86. Bond and license of auctioneer selling only books, maps or prints.
87. Bond and license of auctioneer selling only horses and carriages.
88. *Nunc pro tunc* license, not to avail party if prosecution for selling without license be commenced before obtaining it.
89. Death of any auctioneer, who may act under license
90. Recognizances, who to take; record to be kept, fee for.
91. Treasurer, when to issue license
92. Persons selling without license, penalty.
93. Auctioneers selling before giving bond and paying license; penalty
94. Auctioneers selling goods other than their licenses permit, penalty.
95. Time within which auctioneers shall take out license, penalty
96. Recognizances to be renewed annually.
97. Sureties removing from State or becoming insolvent; duty of treasurer.
98. Forfeiture of appointment under this sub-title by acceptance of appointment as auctioneer from another State.

110. Auctioneer failing to carry out provisions of section 108, or not sending to treasurer duplicate of his recognizance, penalty.
111. Auctioneer who has not sold any property liable to duties within time limited for accounts, to make affidavit to such fact.
