668. Not applicable to owners and masters of vessels selling wood

Duty of Sheriff.

669. To make annually in May alphabetical list of all persons engaged in business for which licenses are required, and return such list to grand jury.

Mariners and Charitable Marine Society of Baltimore.

670. Estate of intestate mariners leaving no relatives, to pass to.

Markets.

- 671. Mayor and city council have power to erect.
- 672. Buying to sell again in market, penalty; proviso.
- 673. Enforcement of, penalty.
- 674. Legal weight of butter sold by the pound; forfeited for light weight.
- 675. Clerks of market may distrain meat for rent of stalls, to collect fines and forfeitures under sections 672-674.
- 676. No charge against non-residents of city for selling in markets, unless from stand in markethouse.
- 677. Penalty for collecting any charges against such vendors.
- 678. Mayor and city council may sell or lease stalls.
- 679. May buy or lease land for purpose of extending any market.
