704. Proceedings in these cases to be the same as under sections 694-701.

Parks-Park Commission.

- 705. Organization of park commission under ordinance of June 4, 1860, confirmed.
- 706. Power of park commission to make rules for government and preservation of order within the parks.
- 707. May regulate speed of vehicles and equestrians within.
- 708. To have powers of conservators of the peace.
- 709. Police board may detail police for the parks.
- Condemnation of land for extension of Druid Hill park or Patterson park, proceedings.
- 711. May enlarge streets and avenues around and leading to such parks; condemnation for these purposes
- 712. May form a zoological collection within Druid Hill park.
- 713. May receive subscriptions for such purpose, may issue certificates for.
- 714. Holder to have free ticket of admission.
- 715. Fee for admission.
- 716. Separate accounts of receipts and expenses to be kept and reported to mayor and city council.
- 717. Park commission may employ persons to obtain and manage zoological collection.

Police.
