Allegany, Cecil, Somerset, Calvert, Washington, Prince George's, St. Mary's, Caroline, Carroll, Queen Anne's, Dorchester, Wicomico, Montgomery, Worcester and Kent counties, and Baltimore city, and all cities, towns or boroughs in which dogs are taxed by municipal ordinance are exempted from the operation of sections 157–162 of article 81 of the code of public general laws, title "Revenue and Taxes."
