110. On the Tuesday next after the first Monday in the month of November, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, and on the same day every two years thereafter, there shall be held in each election district in Calvert county, an election for a road commissioner of said district, at which each voter of the said district entitled to vote for a representative in congress shall have the right to vote; and the said election shall be held by the judges authorized to hold an election for a representative in congress; and the person having the largest number of votes shall be deemed duly elected road commissioner for said district; and the whole number of persons thus elected shall constitute a commission to be styled "the board of road commissioners of Calvert county."

111. On the second Tuesday in March succeeding their election, the said board of road commissioners shall meet at Prince Frederick, in an office to be provided for them by the county commissioners of said county, and shall qualify by each taking an oath before the clerk of the circuit court for said county, "that he will faithfully and diligently, and to the best of his ability, execute the office of road commissioner of Calvert county," and shall then organize by electing one of their number to be the president of said board; and on the same day, or as soon thereafter as possible, they shall appoint a person from each election district to be the road supervisor of said district, to serve for two years, or until removed by the board of road commissioners; and it shall be the duty of the county commissioners of said county to provide an office suitably furnished for the use of the said board of road commissioners, and such books as they may require.

Before the first day in April next succeeding their election, the road commissioners and road supervisor of each district shall ride over and inspect the public roads in their respective districts; and the said commissioners shall advise and instruct the said supervisors as to the manner in which the said roads shall
