141. All fines collected under the preceding section shall be paid by the justice of the peace before whom such conviction shall be had, and whose duty it is made to collect the same, over to the county commissioners, within a period of thirty days after receiving the same

142. It shall not be lawful for any person not an actual resident of Calvert, Anne Arundel, Prince George's, St Mary's and Charles counties, to shoot or trap upon the waters of the Patuxent river, its tributaries, or the marshes bordering upon the same, any goose, duck, snipe, ortolan or other wild fowl.

143. Any person who may be found violating the provisions of the preceding section, shall, upon conviction thereof before a justice of the peace of the county wherein the offence was committed, be fined not less than ten dollars, nor more than fifty dollars for the first offence, and not less than twenty-five nor more than one hundred dollars for each subsequent offence; and the boat, gun, ammunition, and all other property found in the possession or use of such person at the time of the arrest, shall be held until such fine is paid, one-half of said fine to go to the informer, the other half to the school fund of the county in which the offence was committed.
