

304. Streets of village part of county roads, county may keep in order as such.
305. Upon neglect to make election, power not to cease, old board to hold over.
306. Additional notary public to be appointed.

Roads.

307. Gates on public roads; where and by what authority they may be erected
308. Order for removal of gates so authorized; notice to be given person who erected, penalty for failure to remove.
309. Fines under section 308, how recovered and to what use to be applied.
310. Racing on public roads and streets.
311. Violation of section 310; penalty
312. Firing guns, pistols or firelocks, where unlawful, penalty.
313. Division of the county among the commissioners for the supervision of road and bridge work.
314. Road districts and road commissioners.
315. Road commissioners, where to reside, oath, contracts for work on roads, how, when, for how long, to be made, and subject to what conditions; contractor's bond, sections of road uncontracted for, report to county commissioners, amount to be expended on roads.
316. Road supervisors, their duties, specifications of manner in which roads are to be made and kept; notice to commissioners of injuries to bridges or obstructions on roads, supervisor, fine for failure to perform his duties, bond liable therefor; complaints, removal from office; bond liable for increased expense, appointment of surety to vacancy; hearing of complaints; bond liable for damages caused by neglect of duty.
317. Road commissioners to have charge of bridges, sluices and trunks; amount to be by them expended in keeping in good condition; inspection of roads and report to commissioners; failure to make report; penalty; general inspection and report; certificates to be issued to supervisors; pay of road commissioners; non-performance of duty; his bond, for what liable.
318. Application for improvements not required by law, new bridges and new roads to be under supervision of road commissioners, inspection before acceptance from contractor, to what bridges not applicable.
319. Draining water into public roads unlawful; penalty; draining water from public roads into adjoining property; damages; natural water-courses crossing public roads
320. Obstruction, filling up or injury to drains or ditches, obstructing roads by ditches or otherwise without order from county commissioners; penalty; removal of obstructions from roads; costs.
321. Survey of roads; alterations in roads; damages to owners of land along road.

Schools.

322. Expenses not to exceed levy; borrowing of money, to what extent lawful, school commissioners responsible for excess.
