**104.** The county commissioners are authorized and required to pay out of the general levy of the county, to the crier of the circuit court, four dollars per day for each day said court is in session and said crier is in attendance therein; which said *per diem* shall be in lieu of all other compensation.

**105.** The county commissioners are required to levy in advance a sum of money sufficient to pay the crier and bailiff of the circuit court; and they shall pay said crier and bailiff upon the presentation of the certificate of the clerk of said court, showing their attendance and service.

**107.** At their first annual meeting in each year, they shall appoint a fit and proper person, a resident of the county, to act as clerk.

**108.** The said clerk, before entering upon the duties of his office shall execute a bond to the State of Maryland, to be approved by the commissioners, in the penalty of one thousand dollars, for the faithful performance of said office, which said bond shall be recorded in the office of the clerk of the circuit court.
