- sale of real estate; procedure, bailiff to account to commissioners.
- Discount for payment within thirty days.
- 72. When taxes shall begin to bear interest; bailiff's bond hable for his failure to account.
- 73. Tenant hable for taxes; may deduct taxes so paid from rent.
- 74. Dog tax; killing of dog on which tax cannot be collected, by-laws to enforce this section.
