239. Where unlawful for non-residents of Dorchester to catch oysters.

240. Warrant for arrest of offenders and seizure of boats and tackle, when returnable.

241. Proceedings; penalty.

242. Disposition to be made of proceeds of sale and fines.

243 Appeal; appeal bond; right to jury trial.

244 License to scoop or dredge in Choptank river; by whom issued; to whom it may be issued, privileges under it; charges.

245. Oath to be taken by owner of boat; by master and crew.

246. Power of owners and masters of licensed boats to arrest.

247. Warrant to be issued by justice of peace against offenders, to whom to issue; for what

255. License to dredge or scrape in waters named, by whom application must be made, privileges under license; transfer of license; what it must contain; charge for license

256. Oath to be taken by owner, oath to be taken by master; license to be exhibited at time of taking oath.

257. Catching oysters without license; fraudulently obtaining license; penalty.

258. Violations of sections 253 to 262; catching oysters in waters not authorized by section 253; penalty, election between trial before justice and before circuit court, bond.

259. Number to be displayed, where; penalty for violations of this section, fines for violations of sections 253 to 262, to what use to be put; failure of justice or sheriff or deputy to pay over to commissioners; penalty, how recovered.

260 Blank licenses under section 255, by whom furnished, return of unused blanks; clerk's fee for issuing license; license money to be turned over to school commissioner, statement required of clerk.

261. Persons violating provisions of section 253 to 262, arrest, hearing, resistance to arrest, penalty; costs in case of acquittal.

262. Violations of sections 253 to 262; liability of owner of boat, sale of boat, proceeds of sale of boat.
