Any packer, commission man, boatman or other person who shall conspire or agree with any other person to evade any of the provisions of this article, or who shall connive at or participate in such violation shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. It shall be unlawful for any captain or other person in charge of a vessel to discharge his oysters, or for any packing-house, or any other person, to receive oysters between the hours of 8 o'clock P. M. and 6 o'clock A. M. Any viola-
