Mortgages,

37. Mortgages when filed with *total* release thereon shall be retained by clerk; otherwise where release is of part only of mortgage.

Leases or Sub-Leases,

85A. Leases or sub-leases for more than 15 years redeemable after 5 years at not more than 6 per cent.

Mortgages.

37. When the mortgage, with the release thereon, is filed for the purpose of recording the release, the clerk shall retain such mortgage in his office and not permit the same to be again withdrawn; provided, however, that if the release is partial in its character, after the recording of the same, the clerk may permit the mortgage to be withdrawn.
