Each local register shall be empowered, with the advice and consent of the board of health, to designate competent persons to the number of not more than two in each election district, who shall act as sub-registers, and shall within the district for which they are appointed issue burial permits and perform such other services under this sub-title as the local board of health may direct during the term for which the *appointing* register was appointed.
