- 65. Between two and four thousand dollars.
- 66. Between four and six thousand dollars.
- 67. Between six and ten thousand dollars.
- 68. Between ten and twenty thousand dollars.

- 70. If more than thirty thousand dollars.
- 71. Person applying must also obtain license to sell goods, etc.

Ordinary Keeper.

- 72. Application; sale of liquors thereunder.
- 73. Terms on which granted.

- 75. Where annual rental does not exceed one hundred dollars.
- 76. Where annual rental is between one and two hundred dollars.

Sales of Intoxicating Liquors By Clubs.

- 87. Clubs selling or dispensing intoxicating liquors must take out license; exception.

- 89. Three-fourths of license money derived from clubs, societies, etc., in Baltimore city to go to mayor and city council of Baltimore.

Penalties.

- 96. Gift of liquor to minor; penalty.
- 97. Penalty for taking out ordinary license without beds, etc., as required.
- 98. Employment of minors to sell beer, etc., penalty.

- 100. Informer; name to be endorsed on indictment.
- 101. Proof of exposure for sale sufficient.
- 102. Clubs may not give, barter or sell spirituous liquors without license. This section not applicable to Baltimore city.
