**State Geological and Economic Survey.**

- 19 State geological and economic survey established; of whom composed.
20. Objects of such survey.
21. Reports to be made to legislature.
22. Regular and special reports to be printed.
23. Disposal of material collected.
24. Commission authorized to make provision for completion of the topographic survey of Maryland, and for the publication of special reports.
25. Appropriation for carrying out the purposes of this sub-title.

**• Public Roads.**

26. Geological and economic commission shall investigate road construction.
27. To make necessary appointments of assistants.
28. Duty of commission to see that proper investigation is made of roads and their improvements.
29. To make report.
30. Record of all monies received and spent to be kept.
31. All monies paid out to be paid by State treasurer.
32. Appropriation of ten thousand dollars annually to carry out these provisions.
33. County commissioners to notify said commission of their intention to build or improve. Plans, specifications and estimates to be furnished by commission.
34. When county commissioners must notify commission.
35. When commission must prepare plans, specifications and estimate.
36. What construction and improvement specifications must require.
37. County commissioners to pay for such plans, specifications and estimate.
38. County commissioners to advertise for bids for such construction or improvement.
39. Awarding of contract.
40. Contract to be subject to approval of commission.
41. Commission to supervise the work.
42. Commission to certify to comptroller completion of the work. Payment for work; how to be made.
43. State to pay no part of cost of acquiring land for road nor damages caused by its construction.
44. Proportion to several counties of State appropriation.
45. Roads built under this article to be county roads and to be kept in repair by county commissioners. Proceedings to compel county commissioners to keep such roads in repair.
46. Special body having control in any county of its public roads to have power and be subject to duties of county commissioners.
47. This article not to affect road construction in several counties at their own expense.
