**55.** No person shall drive or propel any vehicle, except a bicycle, upon any of the sidepaths now constructed or hereafter to be constructed in any of the counties of the State in which a county board or sidepath commissioners have been appointed. No person shall ride or propel any bicycle on any sidepath constructed or hereafter to be constructed in such county, unless a valid bicycle sidepath license be attached or affixed in plain view to the head of the frame or left side of the front fork, as may be determined by the said board of State sidepath commissioners.

**56.** No person shall drive or hitch any horse, cattle, sheep, swine or other animal on any sidepath now constructed or hereafter to be constructed under the provisions of this sub-title.

**57.** No person shall wilfully obstruct, injure or destroy any sidepath or any portion thereof now constructed or to be constructed under the provisions of this sub-title.

**58.** Bicycle riders riding in opposite directions on said path shall turn to the right in passing and every bicycle overtaking another on said path shall turn to the left in passing.

**59.** The sidepaths heretofore constructed and hereafter to be constructed in any county in which county boards of sidepath commissioners have been appointed under the provisions of this sub-title are hereby placed under the control and direction of said county board of sidepath commissioners, but subject to the general supervision and direction of the State board of sidepath commissioners.

**60.** Such board of sidepath commissioners, with the consent of the road supervisors or other officers performing similar duties having jurisdiction thereof may remove limbs of trees overhanging any sidepath in such county when in the judgment of said board the same interfere with the free passage of bicycles along said path.
