- 172. Investments to be made in name of ward; how transferable.
- 173. No sale valid without order of orphans' court; revocation of letters for unauthorized sale.
- 174. Revocation to extend only to guardian who so sells, where there are several guardians.
- 175. Sections 173 and 174 not to apply where guardian has power by will to sell without making application to court.
- 176. What guardian's first account shall state.
