Bills of exceptions shall be so prepared as only to present to the court of appeals the rulings of the court below upon some matter of law, and shall contain only such statement of facts as may be necessary to explain the bearing of the rulings upon the issues or questions involved; and if the facts are undisputed, they shall be stated as facts, and the evidence from which they are deduced shall not be set out; and if dis-
