

186. Articles whose component parts are made of the same metal, soldered together, marked sterling or sterling silver, to contain nine hundred and twenty-five one-thousandths of pure silver.
187. Articles whose component parts are made of the same metal, soldered together, stamped coin or coin silver, to contain nine hundred one-thousandths of pure silver.
