404. No person or association of persons shall, either directly or indirectly, by agent or otherwise, use or hold for use in any way, or sell any stamp commonly called a trading stamp, or any ticket, or check, or any written or printed promise or assurance, express or implied, or any other scheme or device for the sale, barter or trade of any goods, wares or merchandise, holding out as an inducement for any such sale, barter or trade the giving or issuing of any such stamp, ticket, check, promise, assurance, scheme or device, which stamp, ticket, check, promise, assurance, scheme or device is to be or may be presented to or redeemed by some person or association of persons other than those making the sale, barter or trade aforesaid, the holder of said stamp, ticket, check, promise, assurance, scheme or device for presentment or redemption getting or receiving in exchange therefor any gift,
