

26. Registration in Baltimore city in 1906 and biennially thereafter.
27. Affidavit in cases of removal from State.
28. Register of names of persons coming into the State with intent to become citizens, cost of such registration.
29. To whom section 28 shall not apply.

Intermediate Registration.

30. Revision of registration in the counties. Certificates of removal Oath of applicant for removal certificate.
31. Registers to be made to agree and be signed.
32. Board of registry to make out list of persons supposed to be dead or suspected to be disqualified.
33. Meeting for revision.
34. Hearing of persons to whom notices were sent.
35. List of registered or erased names to be printed and posted
36. Persons aggrieved may file petitions.
37. Vacancies, how filled.
38. Revision of registration in Annapolis.
39. Inspection of registers may be permitted in presence of some member of the board of supervisors.
