ARTICLE XVI.

CHANCERY.

Divorce.

39. Divorce *a mensa et thoro* not to interfere with subsequent bill for divorce *a vinculo matrimonii*. Divorce *a mensa et thoro* for abandonment not to estop party from afterwards obtaining divorce *a vinculo matrimonii* for abandonment specified in section 36.

Trustee.

215 A. Additional mode of distribution by fiduciaries of trust property where the distributees may be unknown or non-residents.

225 B. Process.

215 C. Counsel may be appointed by court for such unknown or non-resident persons.

215 D. Three preceding sections not to repeal existing law.

233 A. Mode of redeeming a redeemable ground rent or sub-ground rent held by trustee or other party not having a power of sale and conveyance—Procedure—Bond to be given—Costs.

233 B. Power of disposal given by deed or will to fiduciaries to be appurtenant to the fiduciary office unless expressly negatived in such deed or will.

When a bill prays for a divorce *a vinculo matrimonii*, the fact that the parties have been divorced *a mensa et thoro* shall not be taken to interfere with the jurisdiction of the court over the subject, and a party who has obtained a divorce *a mensa et thoro* on the ground of abandonment, which at the time of obtaining said divorce was not of the character and
