Accept deed of transfer.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized to accept a deed of transfer to this State of said "Pikesville Arsenal property," to be held by it in trust as specified in said act, and that he communicate to the Secretary of War, forthwith, the assent of the State so to accept the same.

When effective. SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 6.

AN ACT to amend and re-enact the first and third sections of article forty-three of the Code of Public General Laws of this State, title "Habeas Corpus," as the same were enacted by the act of January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, and to amend, and re-enact as amended, the thirteenth section of the same article, and to add an additional section to said article forty-three, providing for taking the opinion of the Court of Appeals in certain cases.

Amended and re-enacted. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the first and third sections of article forty-three of the Code of Public General Laws of this State, title "Habeas Corpus," as the same were enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter three hundred and seventy-three, be amended, and re-enacted as amended, so that the same shall read as follows:

Grant writ of "Habeas Corpus." 1. The Court of Appeals and the Chief Justice of this State shall have the power to grant the writ of "Habeas Corpus," and to exercise jurisdiction in
