SEC. 8. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect when the same shall have been accepted by a majority of the shareholders of the Baltimore and Cumberland Valley Railway Company, at a meeting duly convened for the purpose; and the said consolidation or consolidations shall become complete, under whatever corporate name or names that may be chosen by the consolidating companies, whenever and as soon as said companies shall have, from time to time, agreed to consolidate their several companies into one, and shall have settled and agreed upon the terms of such consolidation in conformity with the provisions of this act, and shall have made a full record and report thereof, certified by the president of the first, or of the subsequent consolidated company, as the case may be, and shall have transmitted the same to the Secretary of State, to be recorded and preserved in his office, a copy of which record, duly authenticated under the seal of the State, shall be evidence thereof in all courts of this State.

CHAPTER 66.

AN ACT to restore William Coulborne, of Isaac, the sum of forty dollars paid by him on a commission to him as Sheriff of Somerset county.

Preamble.

WHEREAS William Coulborne, of Isaac, was elected Sheriff of Somerset county in eighteen hundred and seventy-five, and was commissioned as such sheriff and qualified under said commission.
