SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take Effective. effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 74.

AN ACT to repeal section forty-two of article three of Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore County," sub-title "Circuit Court," as amended and reenacted by chapter eighty-five, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy eight, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section forty-two of article three of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore County," sub-title "Circuit Court," as amended and re-enacted by chapter eighty-five, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Repealed and 1e-enacted.

SEC. 42. There shall be annually four terms of the Circuit Court for Baltimore county held at Towsontown, in said county, commencing respectively on the first Monday in March, the third Monday in May, the second Monday in September, and the first Monday in December.
