

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant on the Treasurer to pay Dr. Wilson G. Register, State Vaccine Agent, the sum of twelve hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be absolutely necessary, to defray the expenses already incurred by him in procuring reliable vaccine virus, and such other necessary and legal expenses as he may incur during the remainder of the present fiscal year, all of which expenses are to be proven to the entire satisfaction of the Comptroller.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 82.

AN ACT to enable the qualified voters of Prince George's county to determine by ballot whether spirituous or fermented liquors or alcoholic bitters shall be sold in said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the question as to whether any person or persons, or any house, may be licensed in Prince George's county, in this State, by whom or in which spirituous or fermented liquors or alcoholic bitters shall be sold, shall be submitted to the registered voters of said county on Tuesday, the twenty-seventh day of April, eighteen hundred and eighty, which election shall be held in accordance with the law governing general elections in this State, and the sheriff of said county shall give notice of the time and purpose of said election by advertisement inserted in all the newspapers published in said county, and by handbills posted in each election district in said county, at least ten days before the said election, in which notice a copy of this
